Create a face mask with a fun design (e.g., animal, superhero)


Description

- Iron (optional, to smooth out fabric)



WAX RESIST COLOURING




Create a wax resist design using multiple colours.



DESCRIPTION

FINGER EXPRESSION


MAKE A FLOWER WITH FINGER EXPRESSION

SKETCH WITH SHAPES


SKETCH AN ELEPHANT WITH SHAPE

CRATIVITY WITH CIRCLES


Draw a rat with circles


SKETCH A PENGUIN WITH THE HELP OF BOXES
